7	“Lost in the Woods”	To understand that once we face our fears they begin to fade away. The power of love overcomes fear.	<i>The Wizard of Oz</i>
8	“Missing Pieces”	To understand that sometimes when we feel as though all is right with the world and our goal is in sight, negativity and fear appear to try to deter us.
